


# Q1 Does the Interstate Bridge affect your household, and if so, in what way?



## Q2 How often is your travel affected by the bridge?



### Q3 What priority would you put on replacing the Interstate Bridge?



## Q4 If you believe replacing the Interstate Bridge should be a priority, why?



## Q5 What is your level of interest in constructing a third bridge over the Columbia, in addition to replacing the Interstate Bridge?




