

Kim Wyman



Kim Wyman served as the 15th Secretary of State for the state of Washington from 2013 to 2021. She was only the second woman to hold the position.

Barriers to voting while living in Germany inspired Wyman to run for Secretary of State. She became one of the first public officials to become a Certified Elections/Registration Administrator.

During her third term, Wyman was the only Republican statewide-elected official and the only one on the west coast. She felt strongly that protecting the integrity of our elections should not be a partisan effort. She often defended Washington's vote-by-mail system.

In an interview with the Associated Press, Wyman said, "My job is to inspire confidence in every voter no matter if they are a staunch Democrat or a hardcore Republican."

Wyman resigned in 2021 to work on election security for the federal government.
