

# **2024 REPUBLICAN WINS**

### Passing three of the initiatives to the Legislature

- Parents' Right to Know: Enshrining parents' rights in K-12 public school (I-2081)
- No Income Tax? Banning a personal income tax (I-2111)
- Reasonable Police Pursuit: Restoring 'reasonable suspicion' as the standard for vehicular pursuit (I-2113)

## Increasing awareness of the other three initiatives to the Legislature

- Repealing the income tax on capital gains (I-2109)
- Repealing the cap-and-tax program (I-2117)
- Allowing people to opt out of the "long-term care" program (I-2124)

### Killing bad bills

#### **Senate**

- <u>SB 5241:</u> Devasting rural hospitals bill
- <u>SB 5770:</u> Tripling the annual allowable property tax growth rate
- <u>SB 5777:</u> Unemployment insurance for strikers

#### House

- HB 1579: Local prosecutors impaired by establishing Office of Independent Prosecutions in A.G.'s office
- HB 1932: Voter suppression by forcing all elections into even years
- HB 2114: Rent control
- <u>HB 2030:</u> "Gary Ridgway Voting Rights Act"
- <u>HB 2065:</u> Resentencing incarcerated offenders to remove the impact of a juvenile offense(s)
- HB 2160: Disincentivizing building near public transit
- HB 2301: Would have reduced grocery store food donations to hunger organization.



### Passing good bills

- Operating budget that has no new taxes
- Capital budget that prioritizes school construction
- Support Republican priorities
  - o Public Safety
    - SB 5812: Calls on Washington State patrol to create recommendations for best practices to respond to electric vehicle fires (J. Wilson)
    - <u>SB 5886:</u> Provides firefighter safety funding (Braun)
    - SB 5891: Designates trespassing on a public-school bus as a felony (Boehnke)
    - SB 5906: Implements a statewide drug overdose prevention and education program (L. Wilson)
    - SB 6099: Creates the tribal opioid prevention treatment account (Braun)

### o Affordability

- <u>SB 5792:</u> Redefines "multiunit residential buildings" (Padden)
- SB 6047: Improves the transparency of executive sessions held by publicly owned natural gas utilities (Warnick)
- SB 6238: Updates thresholds for the property tax exemption for widows and widowers of honorably discharged veterans (Dozier)

#### Better Future for Kids

- SB 5647: Provides school safety training to temporary school employees
  (Torres)
- <u>SB 5670:</u> Permits 10th grade students to participate in the Running Start program in online settings (Hawkins)
- <u>SB 5852:</u> Provides funding for the special education safety net (Braun)
- SB 6053: Improves equitable access to postsecondary education (Holy)
- <u>SB 6234:</u> Provides screening for newborn infants for the often-overlooked branched-chain ketoacid dehydrogenase kinase deficiency (L. Wilson)
