2026 SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL & TRANSPORTATION BUDGETS

CAPITAL PROJECTS

- K-12 Education: \$109.677 million
- Housing & Homelessness: \$200 million
- Agriculture: \$16.822 million
- Natural Resources: \$73.5 million
- Law Enforcement: \$1.6 million
- Flood Response: \$14 million
- Water Projects: \$25.082 million

CAPITAL BUDGET

The capital budget invests in long-term physical infrastructure across the state. It funds the construction, renovation, and repair of public buildings and facilities, including schools, universities, behavioral health facilities, housing projects, water systems, and other community assets.

\$889.7 MILLION

On top of the \$7.5 billion allocated in 2025

TRANSPORTATION BUDGET

The transportation budget supports the state's roads, bridges, ferries, and transit systems. It funds highway construction and preservation, ferry operations, public transportation grants, and transportation safety projects to help move people and goods efficiently and safely throughout the state.

\$1.2 BILLION

On top of the \$15.5 billion allocated in 2025

TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

- Preservation:
 - \$300 million - current budget
 - \$400 million - 2027-29 budget
 - \$400 million - 2029-31 budget
- Disaster Relief: \$45 million
 - 80% reimbursed by federal dollars
- Ferries: \$28 million over 6 years
- State Patrol: \$2.7 million
- Dredging the Columbia River: \$10 million
 - Another \$5 million from the capital budget
