## 2026 UNCONSTITUTIONAL INCOME TAX

### INCOME TAX HEARINGS

- ✓ House and Senate hearings
- ✓ 118,421 unique CON sign-ins
- ✓ Testimony 2 to 1 opposed
- ✓ Democrats gaslit the opposition, blaming bots for the highest numbers in state history

### SB 6346 - INCOME TAX

- UNCONSTITUTIONAL
- \$3.2 BILLION PER YEAR
- 9.9% TAX ON EVERYONE
- \$1 MILLION DEDUCTION (TEMPORARY)
- MARRIAGE PENALTY
- CAN'T BE OVERTURNED BY REFERENDUM

### HURTS SMALL BUSINESS

"The new tax is technically an individual income tax – but for owners of LLCs, S corporations, partnerships, and sole proprietorships, the business' income flows directly to their personal tax returns. If their share of business income, combined with other Washington taxable income, pushes them above the threshold, they may owe." - *Geekwire, March 15, 2026*

### DEMOCRATS' RESPONSE TO RECORD OPPOSITION

- "We don't pay attention to people who sign in, but not to testify."  
(Wanting to testify - 308 CON, 163 PRO = 2 to 1)
- "We don't think everyone who is signing in support or opposition is reading the bill so I think you gotta take it for what it's worth."
- "It's not like we're making decisions not to pass a bill because of a sign-in."
- "They're not helping us make decisions."

### LEADING THE CHARGE

SRC led the grassroots campaign to oppose the income tax, making it the most unpopular bill in state history.

- Multiple eblasts to over 1.2 MILLION people
- 4 MILLION+ impressions on our call to action for the hearing in the House alone
- More than 118,000 people signed in CON
